Purposes and legal bases

We process data necessary to provide, secure and maintain the Website on the basis of our legitimate interest (Article 6(1)(f) GDPR). Analytical cookies are used only where consent has been granted (Article 6(1)(a) GDPR).

When you contact us via Instagram, we process the information contained in your correspondence solely to respond to your enquiry and manage communication, relying on our legitimate interest (Article 6(1)(f) GDPR).

We may also process personal data where necessary to establish, exercise or defend legal claims pursuant to Article 6(1)(f) GDPR.

Cookies

The Website uses cookies exclusively to support its operation, improve functionality and generate aggregated usage statistics. Please refer to the Cookie Policy for detailed information.

Recipients of data

Personal data may be shared with IT service providers and other entities supporting the operation of the Website, as well as with competent public authorities where disclosure is required by law.

International transfers

Where service providers process data outside the EEA, transfers are carried out in compliance with GDPR requirements and appropriate safeguards.

Retention period

Personal data are retained only for as long as necessary for the purposes for which they were collected, until consent is withdrawn or a valid objection is raised where applicable, unless a longer retention period is required by law or necessary for legal claims.
